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FEBRUARY 2016 OPERATING RESULTS

In February 2016, Singapore Airlines' capacity (measured in available seat kilometres) grew by 2.1% due to the effect of the longer month, partially offset by the reduction in seats with the introduction of Premium Economy. Passenger carriage (measured in revenue passenger kilometres) increased 5.1% compared to last year, outpacing capacity growth and resulting in an improvement in systemwide passenger load factor (PLF) by 2.2 percentage points to 77.4%.

Supported by promotional activities, PLF improved across all route regions. The competitive landscape continues to be challenging and promotional activities will continue in relevant markets.

SilkAir's systemwide passenger carriage grew 11.6% year-on-year, well ahead of capacity growth of 9.8%. Consequently, PLF increased by 1.3 percentage points to 74.0%. Growth in passenger carriage exceeded capacity growth for both the East Asia and Pacific region and the West Asia region, resulting in a 1.3 percentage point and 1.2 percentage point improvement in PLF respectively.

Scoot's systemwide PLF fell by 2.1 percentage points to 86.8%, as growth in passenger carriage of 48.2% did not keep pace with the capacity increase of 51.8%.

Tigerair recorded a 4.9% year-on-year improvement in systemwide passenger carriage, while capacity increased at a slower pace of 1.5%, resulting in 2.7 percentage point growth in PLF to 81.6%.

Overall cargo load factor (CLF) was 4.3 percentage points lower, with cargo traffic (measured in freight-tonnekilometres) declining 2.3% against overall capacity growth of 4.9%. West Asia and Africa was the only region which showed an improvement in load factor, with demand outpacing capacity changes.

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
