Coliwoo to Convert State-Owned Property 159 Jalan Loyang Besar into its First Resort Chalet

- LHN Limited, through its co-living subsidiary Coliwoo Keppel Pte. Ltd., has won the tender for 159 Jalan Loyang Besar – a SLA-owned property spanning a gross floor area of 106,949 sq ft.
- With plans to be converted into Coliwoo's first resort chalet, the revamped property will yield over 350 keys, making it Coliwoo's third-biggest property and a signature eco lifestyle hub destination in Singapore's eastern region.
- Expected to commence operations in 3QFY2026, the resort chalet is positioned to attract a steady flow of international tourists and professionals working near Changi Airport and Changi Business Park, presenting a prime opportunity for commercial tenants to establish themselves within a vibrant community.

Singapore, 2 June 2025 — Coliwoo, a co-living subsidiary brand under real estate management services group, LHN Limited ("**LHN**", together with its subsidiaries, the "**Group**") (SGX: 410 / SEHK: 1730), has recently won the tender for tenancy of a state-owned property at **159 Jalan Loyang Besar**, with plans to convert it into the Group's first resort-style chalet under the Coliwoo brand.

The property sits on Singapore Land Authority ("**SLA**") land area spanning 380,866 sq ft and a gross floor area of 106,949 sq ft, consisting of 20 two-storey buildings, four single-storey structures and vehicle lots.

An Urban Retreat in Nature Rooted in Community

Surrounded by popular recreational attractions like Downtown East and Wild Wet, along with natural escapes like Pasir Ris Beach, the location offers strong appeal to both local residents and international visitors seeking flexible, contemporary co-living options.

Upon completion of the asset enhancement, the property will be transformed into a vibrant co-living destination that seamlessly blends lifestyle, community and nature. With its proximity to key landmarks and natural attractions of Singapore's eastern region, 159 Jalan Loyang Besar will serve as a gateway for guests to engage with the surrounding environment, promoting holistic wellness and a balanced way of living.

Designed to promote wellness, shared experience and foster connection with nature, the resort chalet will offer thoughtfully curated communal spaces that encourage social interaction and a sense of belonging. Guests can look forward to a wide range of wellness-centric facilities including swimming pools, indoor and outdoor sports zones, and meditation gardens while building meaningful connections at social lounges, BBQ pits, multi-purpose halls, event plazas and through joining social bonding events organised by Coliwoo.

Designed as a multi-purpose lifestyle destination for a wide demographic, including families, digital nomads, and corporate groups, the layout will be reconfigured to accommodate over 350 keys, doubling the current unit count to maximise space efficiency while maintaining comfort and quality for guests. This will be Coliwoo's third-biggest property, after Coliwoo Boon Lay and flagship Coliwoo Orchard.

With a strong emphasis on sustainability and harmony with nature, the site will undergo extensive landscaping and pathway enhancements to weave greenery into its every corner and improve connectivity with the surroundings. The development will also integrate solar energy systems and support green mobility with features such as electric vehicle charging stations and dedicated cycling paths.

Inspired by Singapore's elegant colonial bungalows, the interior features a refined tropical aesthetic that respects architectural heritage while embracing modern expression. A restrained black-and-white colour scheme sets the tone indoors, allowing the surrounding greenery to shine. The approximately 10-month renovation period is expected to commence in the second half of our financial year ending 30 September 2025, with extensive works planned to align the property with Coliwoo's signature co-living concept. The revamped residence is targeted to be operational in the third quarter of our financial year ending 30 September 2026 ("3QFY2026"), adding a signature eco lifestyle hub destination in Singapore's eastern region.
