- The Ordinary Resolution 9 is to approve the appointment of Messrs KPMG LLP as the auditors of the company in place of the retiring auditors, Messrs Ernst & Young LLP, and to authorise the Directors to fix their remuneration. Detailed information relating to this resolution is set out in the Circular relating to the Proposed Change of Auditors dated 4 April 2014.
 - $The \textit{ Ordinary Resolution 10 in item 7 above, if passed, will empower the \textit{ Directors of the Company, effective until the conclusion of the next Annual Company and Compan$ General Meeting ("AGM") of the Company, or the date by which the next AGM of the Company is required by law to be held or such authority is $varied\ or\ revoked\ by\ the\ Company\ in\ a\ general\ meeting, whichever\ is\ the\ earlier,\ to\ issue\ shares,\ make\ or\ grant\ Instruments\ convertible\ into\ shares$ and to issue shares pursuant to such Instruments, up to a number not exceeding, in total, 50% of the total number of issued shares (excluding treasury shares) in the capital of the Company, of which up to 20% may be issued other than on a pro-rata basis to shareholders.

For determining the aggregate number of shares that may be issued, the total number of issued shares (excluding treasury shares) will be calculated based on the total number of issued shares (excluding treasury shares) in the capital of the Company at the time this Ordinary Resolutionis passed after adjusting for new shares arising from the conversion or exercise of any convertible securities or share options or vesting of share awards and the conversion of the conversiowhich are outstanding or subsisting at the time when this Ordinary Resolution is passed and any subsequent bonus issue, consolidation or subdivisionof shares.

- A Member entitled to attend and vote at the Annual General Meeting (the "Meeting") is entitled to appoint not more than two proxies to attend and vote in his/her stead. A proxy need not be a Member of the Company.
