#### **REVIEW OF THE GROUP'S PERFORMANCE**

#### Revenue

Revenue increased by S\$14.5 million or 27.0% from S\$53.6 million in 9M-2014 to S\$68.1 million in 9M-2015, and increased by S\$4.5 million or 23.4% from S\$19.2 million in 3Q-2014 to S\$23.6 million in 3Q-2015. This was mainly due to increases in revenue from both the pawnbroking segment, and the retail and trading of pre-owned jewellery and watches segment. As at 30 September 2015, the Group had increased its total retail outlets to 49 from 44 as at 30 September 2014.

## **Other Gains**

Other gains decreased by S\$0.2 million or 18.1% from S\$1.0 million in 9M-2014 to S\$0.8 million in 9M-2015. The decrease was mainly due to the reversal in inventories provision of S\$0.3 million in 9M-2014, partially offset by an increase in rental income of S\$0.1 million in 9M-2015.

Other gains remained relatively stable at S\$0.2 million in 3Q-2015 and 3Q-2014.

### **Material Costs**

Material costs increased by \$\$10.1 million or 28.5% from \$\$35.4 million in 9M-2014 to \$\$45.5 million in 9M-2015, and increased by \$\$3.4 million or 27.2% from \$\$12.4 million in 3Q-2014 to \$\$15.8 million in 3Q-2015. The increase in material costs was generally in line with the increase in revenue from the retail and trading of pre-owned jewellery and watches segment in 9M-2015 and 3Q-2015, respectively.

### **Employee Benefits Expense**

Employee benefits expense increased by \$\$1.3 million or 20.2% from \$\$6.4 million in 9M-2014 to \$\$7.7 million in 9M-2015, and increased by \$\$0.2 million or 10.7% from \$\$2.3 million in 3Q-2014 to \$\$2.5 million in 3Q-2015. This was mainly due to the increase in the number of employees arising from the expansion of the Group's network of retail outlets in Singapore and Malaysia as well as annual salary increments for existing employees.

### **Depreciation and Amortisation Expense**

Depreciation and amortisation expense decreased by \$\$0.3 million or 15.2% from \$\$1.7 million in 9M-2014 to \$\$1.4 million in 9M-2015, and decreased by \$\$0.2 million or 26.1% from \$\$0.6 million in 3Q-2014 to \$\$0.4 million in 3Q-2015. The decrease in depreciation and amortisation expense was mainly due to the renovation of certain retail outlets which had been fully depreciated by the second quarter ended 30 June 2015.



#### **Finance Costs**

Finance costs increased by S\$0.5 million or 28.7% from S\$1.8 million in 9M-2014 to S\$2.3 million in 9M-2015, and increased by S\$0.1 million or 22.4% from S\$0.7 million in 3Q-2014 to S\$0.8 million in 3Q-2015. The increase was mainly due to the increase in interest rate and a higher usage of bank facilities to fund the operational cash requirements, which was in tandem with the increase in revenue, and for expansion in Malaysia.

#### Other Losses

Other losses increased by S\$0.3 million or 66.5% from S\$0.5 million in 9M-2014 to S\$0.8 million in 9M-2015. This was mainly attributed to foreign exchange losses incurred by the Group's Malaysian subsidiaries, as a result of the weakening of the Malaysian Ringgit against the Singapore Dollar.

Other losses remained relatively stable at S\$0.4 million in 3Q-2015 and 3Q-2014.

#### Other Expenses

Other expenses for 9M-2015 increased by \$\$0.7 million or 8.8% from \$\$7.7 million in 9M-2014 to \$\$8.4 million in 9M-2015, and remained relatively stable at \$\$2.8 million and \$\$2.7 million in 3Q-2015 and 3Q-2014, respectively. This was mainly due to an increase in rental and related costs pertaining to the new retail outlets which were mainly opened in Singapore and the Malaysian Investment, which was partially offset by the absence in 9M-2015 of professional fees incurred in relation to the Malaysian Investment.

#### **Profit Before Tax**

As a result of the above, profit before tax increased by \$\$1.7 million or 154.5% from \$\$1.1 million in 9M-2014 to \$\$2.8 million in 9M-2015, and increased by \$\$0.8 million or 361.6% from \$\$0.2 million in 3Q-2014 to \$\$1.0 million in 3Q-2015.

### **Income Tax Expense**

Income tax expense increased by \$\$0.4 million or 142.0% from \$\$0.3 million in 9M-2014 to \$\$0.7 million in 9M-2015, and increased by \$\$0.1 million or 78.3% from \$\$0.1 million in 3Q-2014 to \$\$0.3 million in 3Q-2015 due to higher profit before tax.

### **REVIEW OF THE GROUP'S FINANCIAL POSITION**

### **Non-Current Assets**

Non-current assets as at 30 September 2015 decreased by approximately S\$0.3 million or 5.3% from S\$5.6 million as at 31 December 2014 to S\$5.3 million as at 30 September 2015. The decrease was mainly attributable to depreciation charges of plant and equipment, which was offset against increase in capital expenditure of S\$0.5 million, and partial offset with an increase in intangible assets of S\$0.6 million, arising from goodwill in relation to the Malaysian Investment.

### **Current Assets**

Current assets as at 30 September 2015 increased by approximately S\$3.3 million or 1.9% from S\$175.4 million as at 31 December 2014 to S\$178.7 million as at 30 September 2015. This was mainly due to the increase in trade and other receivables of S\$10.2 million which arose mainly from the increase in pledged loans extended to customers. This was partially offset by a decrease in inventories of S\$3.4 million which was mainly due to the higher level of activity from the retail and trading of preowned jewellery and watches segment and cash and cash equivalents of S\$2.7 million.

### **Non-Current Liabilities**

Non-current liabilities decreased by \$\$0.9 million or 26.9% from \$\$3.5 million as at 31 December 2014 to \$\$2.5 million as at 30 September 2015. This was mainly due to the repayment of long-term bank loans which were used to finance the Malaysian Investment.



#### **Current Liabilities**

Current liabilities increased by approximately \$\$2.7 million or 2.2% from \$\$119.5 million as at 31 December 2014 to \$\$122.2 million as at 30 September 2015. This was mainly due to an increase in bank borrowings of \$\$3.8 million to the increase in the pawnbroking segment; which was offset by a decrease in trade and other payables.

### **Equity Attributable to Owners of the Company**

Equity attributable to owners of the Company increased by S\$1.0 million or 1.7% from S\$57.8 million as at 31 December 2014 to S\$58.8 million as at 30 September 2015. The increase was mainly due to profit net of tax attributable to owners of the Company of S\$2.1 million for 9M-2015, which was offset by the payment of ordinary dividends of S\$1.1 million in respect of the previous financial year ended 31 December 2014.

### **REVIEW OF THE GROUP'S CASH FLOW STATEMENT**

In 9M-2015, the net cash generated from operating activities before changes in working capital was \$\$6.9 million. Net cash used in working capital amounted to \$\$7.2 million. This was mainly due to the increase in trade and other receivables and decrease in trade and other payables of \$\$8.2 million and \$\$3.2 million, respectively, which was partially offset by a decrease in inventories of \$\$3.4 million. The net cash used in operating activities amounted to \$\$0.8 million after deducting income tax paid of \$\$0.5 million.

Net cash used in investing activities amounted to S\$1.7 million, and was mainly due to (i) renovation costs and purchase of plant and equipment related to the relocation of existing retail outlets in Singapore and in connection with the Malaysian Investment of S\$0.5 million; and (ii) net cash consideration paid for the Malaysian Investment of S\$1.2 million.

Net cash generated from financing activities of S\$4.1 million was mainly due to the increase from new bank borrowings of approximately S\$7.6 million and proceeds from the issuance of shares in the Group's Malaysian subsidiaries to the Group's Malaysian partner in proportion to his 49.0% shareholding in the Malaysian Investment of S\$0.3 million. These were partially offset by interest paid, dividends paid and repayment of bank borrowings of S\$2.3 million, S\$1.1 million and S\$0.5 million, respectively.

As a result of the above, there was a net cash increase of S\$1.6 million in cash and cash equivalents from a net cash surplus of S\$2.8 million as at 31 December 2014 to a net cash surplus of S\$4.4 million as at 30 September 2015.

In October 2015, the Registry of Pawnbrokers in Singapore has ceased the practice of public auctions for unredeemed pawned valuables, which means that pawnbrokers can dispose off unredeemed articles in manners which will improve administrative and operational efficiency, and at same time reduce business cost.

On 30 October 2015, the Company was awarded 3 prestigious awards - (i) Winner - Established Brands 2015; (ii) Most Popular Brand Award - Established Brand 2015: and (iii) Hall of Fame Award at the Singapore Prestige Brand Award (SPBA) 2015 event organised jointly by the Association of Small and Medium Enterprise (ASME) and Lianhe Zaobao. The Company will continue to leverage on its brand recognition to enhance its market image and position, and to grow its market share.

Notwithstanding the above, the Group continues to operate in a challenging and competitive business environment. The volatility of the Malaysian Ringgit against the Singapore dollar continues, which may translate into foreign exchange losses on the Group's Malaysian operations.
