REVIEW OF FINANCIAL PERFORMANCE (CONSOLIDATED STATEMENT OF COMPREHENSIVE INCOME)

Revenue

2Q FY2019 vs 2Q FY2018

Our Group's revenue increased by approximately S\$5.5 million or 41.2% in 2Q FY2019, from 2Q FY2018 to approximately S\$18.8 million. The increase was due to Promotion revenue and Other revenue by S\$8.5 million or 95.3% and S\$0.2 million or 175.8% respectively. This was offset by a decrease in Production revenue by S\$3.2 million.

1H FY2019 vs 1H FY2018

Our Group's revenue increased by approximately S\$5.3 million or 27.3% in 1H FY2019, from 1H FY2018 to approximately S\$24.8 million. The increase was due to Promotion revenue and Other revenue by S\$7.3 million or 60.3% and S\$0.2 million or 88.7% respectively. This was offset by a decrease in Production revenue by S\$2.2 million.

Cost of sales

2Q FY2019 vs 2Q FY2018

Cost of sales increased by S\$3.6 million or 39.8% in 2Q FY2019, from 2Q FY2018 to approximately S\$12.5 million. The cost of sales attributable to Promotion revenue was approximately S\$4.3 million. This was offset by the lower cost of sales attributable to both Production revenue and Other revenue by S\$0.7 million.

1H FY2019 vs 1H FY2018

Cost of sales increased by S\$2.4 million or 19.2% in 1H FY2019, from 1H FY2018 to approximately S\$14.7 million. The cost of sales attributable to Promotion revenue and Other revenue were approximately S\$2.8 million and S\$0.1 million. This was offset by the lower cost of sales attributable to Production revenue by S\$0.5 million respectively.

Gross profit

2Q FY2019 vs 2Q FY2018

Our gross profit increased by S\$1.9 million or 44.1%, from the corresponding period in 2Q FY2018 to approximately S\$6.3 million in 2Q FY2019. The overall increase was mainly attributed to an increase in Promotion and Other segment, which contributed approximately S\$4.2 million and S\$0.2 million respectively, offset by decrease from Production segment by S\$2.5 million.

1H FY2019 vs 1H FY2018

Our gross profit increased by S\$3.0 million or 41.2%, from the corresponding period in 1H FY2018 to approximately S\$10.2 million in 1H FY2019. The increase was attributed to Promotion segment and Other segment which contributed approximately S\$4.5 million and S\$0.2 million respectively, offset by a decrease from Production segment by S\$1.7 million.

Other income

2Q FY2019 vs 2Q FY2018

Our Group's other income decreased by approximately S\$23,283 or 60.8% in 2Q FY2019 from 2Q FY2018 to approximately S\$15,001. This was mainly due to decrease in interest income from bank deposit.

1H FY2019 vs 1H FY2018

Our Group's other income decreased by approximately S\$0.2 million or 77.4% in 1H FY2019 from 1H FY2018 to approximately S\$0.1 million. This was mainly due to the absence of a one-off trading income in 1H FY2018.

Other gains and losses - net

2Q FY2019 vs 2Q FY2018

Other (losses)/gains decreased by approximately S\$0.1 million or 64.9% in 2Q FY2019 compared to 2Q FY2018. This was due to loss on foreign exchange.

1H FY2019 vs 1H FY2018

Other (losses)/gains increased by S\$0.2 million in 1H FY2019 compared to 1H FY2018. This was mainly contributed by the gains on foreign exchange and disposal of motor vehicles 1H FY2019.

Administrative expenses

2Q FY2019 vs 2Q FY2018

Administrative expenses increased by S\$0.6 million or 42.4% from the corresponding period in 2Q FY2018 to approximately S\$2.0 million in 2Q FY2019. This was mainly due to an increase in staff costs by S\$0.5 million and an increase in amortisation expense by S\$0.1 million in 2Q FY2019.

1H FY2019 vs 1H FY2018

Administrative expenses increased by S\$0.6 million or 24.4% from the corresponding period in 1H FY2018 to approximately S\$3.2 million in 1H FY2019. This was mainly due to an increase in staff costs of S\$0.6 million in 1H FY2019.

Profit before income tax

2Q FY2019 vs 2Q FY2018

We recorded an increase of S\$1.2 million or 40.5% in profit before tax from the corresponding period in 2Q FY2018 to approximately S\$4.3 million in 2Q FY2019.

1H FY2019 vs 1H FY2018

We recorded an increase of S\$2.4 million or 49.0% in profit before tax from the corresponding period in 1H FY2018 to approximately S\$7.2 million in 1H FY2019.

REVIEW OF FINANCIAL POSITION (CONSOLIDATED STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL POSITION)

30 September 2018 vs 31 March 2018

Non-current assets

As at 30 September 2018, non-current assets increased by S\$0.5 million or 3.9%, from approximately S\$12.2 million as at 31 March 2018 to approximately S\$12.7 million due to purchase of property, plant and equipment and amortisation of intangible asset during the financial period.

Current assets

As at 30 September 2018, current assets increased by S\$7.3 million or 18.6% from approximately S\$39.0 million as at 31 March 2018 to approximately S\$46.3 million which represents 78.5% of our total assets. The breakdown is as follows:

- (i) Cash and bank balances decreased by S\$11.9 million or 64.8%, from S\$18.3 million as at 31 March 2018 to S\$6.4 million. This was mainly due to cash being disbursed for upcoming Promotion and Production project.
- (ii) Trade and other receivables increased by S\$19.1 million or 92.9%, from S\$20.6 million as at 31 March 2018 to S\$39.7 million. This increase was mainly due to the following:
 - Increase in other receivable, deposit, prepayment and deferred cost by S\$14.8 million in relation to upcoming Promotion and Production projects/ activities;
 - Increase in trade receivables and accrued revenue by S\$4.3 million.

Non-current liabilities

As at 30 September 2018, non-current liabilities remained the same as at 31 March 2018. There was no movement in deferred income tax liabilities.

Current liabilities

As at 30 September 2018, current liabilities increased by S\$2.1 million or 19.2%, from approximately S\$11.1 million as at 31 March 2018 to S\$13.2 million, representing 96.5% of our total liabilities and comprised the following:

- (i) Trade and other payables increased by S\$1.5 million or 16.0%, from approximately S\$9.1 million as at 31 March 2018 to approximately S\$10.6 million.
- (ii) Borrowings decreased by S\$4,413 or 100.0% from S\$4,413 as at 31 March 2018 due to the repayment of finance lease liabilities.

As at 30 September 2018 (1H FY2019), our cash and cash equivalents amounted to approximately S\$6.5 million as compared to cash and cash equivalents of approximately S\$18.2 million as at 30 September 2017 (1H FY2018).

Net cash used in operating activities

For 2Q FY2019, we generated a net cash inflow of approximately S\$4.8 million from operating activities before working capital changes. Our net working capital changes was due to net cash outflow of approximately S\$9.0 million, comprising an increase in trade and other receivables by S\$10.1 million, inventories by S\$11,614 and income tax paid by S\$0.9 million. This was offset with the increase in trade and other payables by S\$2.0 million. The increase in trade and other receivables was due to the increase in Promotion and Production activities. The increase in trade and other payables was due to a decrease in payment to suppliers.

For 1H FY2019, we generated a net cash inflow of approximately S\$8.0 million from operating activities before working capital changes. Our net working capital changes was due to net cash outflow of approximately S\$18.5 million, comprising an increase in trade and other receivables by S\$19.1 million and income tax paid by S\$0.9 million. This was offset with the increase in trade and other payables by S\$1.5 million, interest received of S\$42,108 and income tax refund of S\$12,023. The increase in trade and other receivables was due to the increase in Promotion and Production activities. The increase in trade and other payables was due to a decrease in payment to suppliers.

Net cash used in investing activities

For 2Q FY2019, net cash used in investing activities amounted to S\$1.2 million mainly attributable from the purchase of plant and equipment.

For 1H FY2019, net cash used in investing activities amounted to S\$1.4 million mainly attributable from the purchase of plant and equipment of approximately S\$1.5 million and offset with the proceeds from disposal of motor vehicles of approximately S\$0.1 million.

Net cash provided by financing activities

For 2Q FY2019, there was no movement in financing activities.

For 1H FY2019, net cash used in financing activities of S\$4,413 was due to the repayment of finance lease liabilities.

Net increase in cash and cash equivalents

For 2Q FY2019, overall, the Group recorded a net cash decrease of approximately S\$5.4 million as compared to the net increase of approximately S\$1.0 million in 2Q FY2018. The difference is mainly due to the net cash used in operating activities and investing activities during the period.

For 1H FY2019, overall, the Group recorded a net cash decrease of approximately S\$11.9 million as compared to the net increase of approximately S\$7.6 million in 1H FY2018. The difference is mainly due to the net cash used in operating activities, investing activities and financing activities during the period.
