COMPLIANCE WITH AND SUPPORT OF SINGAPORE'S MULTI MINISTRY TASK FORCE "CIRCUIT BREAKER" TO MINIMIZE FURTHER SPREAD OF COVID-19

The board of directors (the "Board") of Boldtek Holdings Limited (the "Company", and together with its subsidiaries, the "Group") refers to the Singapore Government's multi ministry task force announcement on 3 April 2020 in relation to Circuit Breaker measures to minimize the further spread of Covid-19 ("Circuit Breaker Measures"). As part of the Circuit Breaker Measures, all work premises will be closed from 7 April 2020 to 4 May 2020, save for those in key economic sectors and essential services.

To comply with the Circuit Breaker Measures, the Group will be suspending non-essential construction activities at all of its construction sites in Singapore for the duration of the Circuit Breaker Measures, except where exempted by the relevant authorities.

At present, the financial impact of the Circuit Breaker Measures cannot be meaningfully quantified. The Board will continue to monitor the evolving situation and make further announcement(s) via SGXNET as and when there are material developments on the aforesaid matter.
