



Snecma appoints SIA Engineering Company as On Site Support provider for CFM LEAP-1A and -1B Engines for Asia-Pacific region

PARIS, 7 APRIL 2016 - Mainboard-listed **SIA Engineering Company Limited** (SIAEC) and Snecma (Safran) have signed an agreement today appointing SIAEC as CFM's authorised On Site Support (OSS) service provider for the LEAP-1A and LEAP-1B engines in Asia Pacific. As a Snecma-approved OSS provider, SIAEC will offer on-wing maintenance services to operators of the CFM LEAP-1A and LEAP-1B engines in Asia-Pacific region.

The LEAP-1A is one of two engine options for the Airbus A320neo family, while the LEAP-1B is the exclusive powerplant for the Boeing 737 MAX. The LEAP engines are produced and marketed by CFM International, a 50/50 joint company between Snecma (Safran) in France and GE in the United States.

SIAEC's Chief Executive Officer, Mr Png Kim Chiang said: "This appointment adds to the growing capabilities of SIAEC on next-generation aircraft. We look forward to the partnership with Snecma to provide OSS support to CFM customers for the LEAP-1A & LEAP-1B engines in this region. Through this partnership, we will be able to provide prompt on-site technical assistance for our airline customers in Asia-Pacific operating these new-generation engines."

Snecma's Vice President of the Services & MRO Division, Mr François Planaud said: "This partnership will allow Snecma to reinforce its capacity to support the LEAP-1A and the LEAP-1B engines that CFM will deliver to its numerous customers in Asia-Pacific. It also provides the opportunity to strengthen the relationships between one company of Safran and SIAEC."

The transaction is not expected to have a material impact on SIAEC's financial performance in FY2016/17. None of the Directors of SIAEC has any interest, direct or indirect, in the transaction.
