Update on Court's Hearing in relation to Incident

The Board of Directors (the "Board") of LY Corporation Limited, (the "Company" and together with its subsidiaries, the "Group") refers to the Company's announcement on 22 August 2019 informing shareholders of the hearing at the court in relation to a factory incident (the "Incident") occurred in LY Furniture Sdn Bhd ("LYSFB"), a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company.

The Board wishes to update that LYFSB has received the verdict after the hearing on 25 September 2019 which Sessions Court of Batu Pahat, Johor, Malaysia ("Court") held that LYFSB shall be liable to a fine of Ringgit Malaysia Forty Thousand (RM40,000.00) due to the offence under Section 15(1) of the Occupational Safety and Health Act for failure to provide a safe mezzanine floor in its premise resulting in a fatal Incident led to casualty. Subsequent to the payment of the fine by LYFSB, the case had been closed on 25 September 2019. The aforementioned is not expected to have any material impact on the financial and operations of the Group for the current financial year ending 31 December 2019.
