By establishing a test procedure in place, the full production capability shall then be tested and certified accordingly. While the Plant has not started its full production, the Company is of the view that an independent third-party test provides a reliable report to our investors and shareholders on the efficiency of the oil production of the Plant.

Further working capital shall be required for the Plant and the Company will be funding the same through a combination of internal resources and through other fund raising activities.

The Company shall keep the shareholders updated in due course when the Plant begins production and when the oil extraction facility is ready.

"I am pleased that we have come a long way to bring this pilot plant to its current stage. During the previous annual general meetings, some shareholders have given feedback that the Company should invite our shareholders and investors to visit our microalgae cultivation plant. We look forward to putting together a site visit to our Kudang Plant." said Kushairi, Chairman.
