The *MP Wind Archer*, owned by the Company's 49 percent owned indirect subsidiary, PKR Offshore Co. This combination of well-positioned facilities and technical expertise was instrumental in the construction of the award-winning *MP Wind Archer*.

This award highlights the Group's growing technical capabilities and its dedication to supporting the transition to a greener blue economy. The *MP Wind Archer* is currently on charter with Vestas in Taiwan, playing a critical role in the renewable energy supply chain in the Asia-Pacific region.



Looking Ahead: The Next-Generation 'CSOV Plus'

Building on the success of the *MP Wind Archer*, Marco Polo Marine is advancing the development of its second CSOV, the CSOV Plus. In collaboration with renowned Norwegian naval architect Salt Ship Design AS, this next-generation vessel will be the first purpose-built CSOV designed from the keel up for dual-sector operations in both the offshore wind and oil & gas markets.

The Group's shipyard business relates to shipbuilding and providing ship maintenance, repair, outfitting, and conversion services through its shipyard in Batam, Indonesia. Occupying a total land area of approximately 34 hectares with a seafront of approximately 650 metres, the modern shipyard also



houses four dry docks, boosting the Group's technical capabilities and service offerings to undertake projects involving mid-sized and sophisticated vessels.
