MINUTES OF THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE COMPANY HELD AT HOPE & FAITH MEETING ROOM, LEVEL 3, YWCA FORT CANNING, 6 FORT CANNING ROAD, SINGAPORE 179494 ON MONDAY, 28 APRIL 2025 AT 3.00 P.M. (the "**Meeting**" or "**AGM**")

Present As per attendance sheets

1. OPENING

- 1.1 The Meeting was chaired by Mr Eddie Chan Yean Hoe, an Independent Director of the Company (the "**Chairman**") with the consent of the Board of Directors (the "**Board**").
- 1.2 Chairman welcomed the shareholders who attended the Meeting and introduced the Directors and officers of the Company.
- 1.3 Chairman informed the Meeting that the shareholders had been invited to post or email questions to the Company in advance of the Meeting. However, the Company had not received any questions related to the resolutions to be tabled at the Meeting from shareholders to-date.

2. QUORUM

A quorum being present, the Chairman called the Meeting to order at 3.00 p.m.

3. BUSINESS REVIEW PRESENTATION

- 3.1 The Chief Financial Officer of the Company was invited to give a business review presentation before proceeding with the formal business of the Meeting.

4. NOTICE

The notice convening the Meeting, which had been issued on 11 April 2025 (the "**AGM Notice**") in accordance with the requisite notice period, was taken as read.

5. VOTING AND APPOINTMENT OF SCRUTINEER

- 5.1 Chairman informed the Meeting that he had been appointed as proxy by certain shareholders who have submitted valid proxy forms to the Company, and that he would be voting in accordance with the proxy votes that he had received.
- 5.2 Chairman highlighted that all valid proxy forms submitted to the Company 72 hours before the Meeting had been verified by the Scrutineer, Reliance 3P Advisory Pte. Ltd.
- 5.3 Chairman proposed all eight (8) resolutions tabled for the Meeting, and requested such resolutions be voted on by a poll. He stated that there was no further need to propose or second each of the resolutions.
- 5.4 Boardroom Corporation & Advisory Services Pte. Ltd. had been appointed as the Polling Agent and Reliance 3P Pte. Ltd. as Scrutineer.

5.5 Chairman invited the Scrutineer to explain the poll voting procedures.

ORDINARY BUSINESS

6. RESOLUTION 1: ADOPTION OF DIRECTORS' STATEMENT, AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS AND INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2024 ("FY2024")

6.1 Chairman informed the Meeting that the first agenda under the ordinary business was to receive and adopt the Audited Financial Statements for FY2024, together with the Directors' Statement and the Independent Auditor's Report, as set out in the Annual Report of the Company.

6.2 Chairman invited shareholders to comment or ask questions on the Audited Financial Statements.

6.3 As there were no questions from the floor, Chairman requested the shareholders to cast their vote for Resolution 1.

7. RESOLUTION 2: RE-ELECTION OF MR HUANG XUHUA AS DIRECTOR

7.1 Chairman informed the Meeting that agenda 2 related to the re-election of Mr Huang as a Director of the Company pursuant to Regulation 91 of the Company's Constitution.

7.2 In accordance with Regulation 91 of the Company's Constitution, Mr Huang retired at the Meeting and being eligible, had offered himself for re-election.

7.3 Chairman invited the shareholders to comment or ask questions on the proposed re-election of Mr Huang.

7.4 As there were no questions from the floor, Chairman requested shareholders to cast their vote for Resolution 2.

8. RESOLUTION 3: RE-ELECTION OF MS LATHA EAPEN K. MATHEW AS DIRECTOR

8.1 Chairman informed the Meeting that agenda 3 related to the re-election of Ms Eapen as a Director of the Company pursuant to Regulation 91 of the Company's Constitution.

8.2 In accordance with Regulation 91 of the Company's Constitution, Ms Eapen retired at the Meeting and being eligible, had offered herself for re-election.

8.3 Chairman invited the shareholders to comment or ask questions on the proposed re-election of Ms Eapen.

8.4 As there were no questions from the floor, Chairman requested shareholders to cast their vote for Resolution 3.

9. RESOLUTION 4: RE-ELECTION OF MS CHEN LEI AS DIRECTOR

9.1 Chairman informed the Meeting that agenda 4 related to the re-election of Ms Chen as a Director of the Company pursuant to Regulation 97 of the Company's Constitution.

- 9.2 In accordance with Regulation 97 of the Company's Constitution, Ms Chen retired at the Meeting and being eligible, had offered herself for re-election.
- 9.3 Chairman invited the shareholders to comment or ask questions on the proposed re-election of Ms Chen.
- 9.4 As there were no questions from the floor, Chairman requested shareholders to cast their vote for Resolution 4.

10. RESOLUTION 5: RE-ELECTION OF MR WANG HONGXIANG AS DIRECTOR

- 10.1 Chairman informed the Meeting that agenda 5 related to the re-election of Mr Wang as a Director of the Company pursuant to Regulation 97 of the Company's Constitution.
- 10.2 In accordance with Regulation 97 of the Company's Constitution, Mr Wang retired at the Meeting and being eligible, had offered himself for re-election.
- 10.3 Chairman invited the shareholders to comment or ask questions on the proposed re-election of Mr Wang.
- 10.4 As there were no questions from the floor, Chairman requested shareholders to cast their vote for Resolution 5.

11. RESOLUTION 6: APPROVAL OF DIRECTORS' FEES OF UP TO S\$600,000 FOR THE FINANCIAL YEAR ENDING 31 DECEMBER 2025 ("FY2025")

- 11.1 Chairman informed the Meeting that agenda 6 was to approve the payment of Directors' fees of up to S\$600,000, to be paid quarterly in arrears to the Non-Executive Directors, for FY2025.
- 11.2 Chairman invited shareholders to comment or ask questions on the Directors' fees.
- 11.3 As there were no questions from the floor, Chairman requested the shareholders to cast their vote for Resolution 6.

12. RESOLUTION 7: RE-APPOINTMENT OF MESSRS ERNST & YOUNG LLP ("EY") AS AUDITOR

- 12.1 Chairman informed the Meeting that agenda 7 was to approve the re-appointment of EY as Auditor of the Company for FY2025 and to authorise the Directors to fix EY's remuneration. He added that EY had indicated their willingness to accept the re-appointment as Auditor of the Company.
- 12.2 Chairman invited shareholders to comment or ask questions on the re-appointment of Auditor.
- 12.3 As there were no questions from the floor, Chairman requested the shareholders to cast their vote for Resolution 7.

- 13. As there was no other Ordinary Business to be transacted at the Meeting, the Meeting proceeded to consider the Special Business.

SPECIAL BUSINESS

14. RESOLUTION 8: RENEWAL OF INTERESTED PERSON TRANSACTIONS ("IPT")

– Minutes of Annual General Meeting held on 28 April 2025

GENERAL MANDATE

- 14.1 Chairman informed the Meeting that the last agenda was to seek shareholders' approval for the renewal of general mandate for the recurrent IPTs.
- 14.2 Chairman referred the Meeting to the full text of Resolution 8 as set out in the AGM Notice and the information relating to, including the rationale for and benefit of, the IPT General Mandate as stipulated in the Appendix to the Company's Annual Report for FY2024 dated 11 April 2025.
- 14.3 Chairman invited shareholders to comment or ask questions on the proposed renewal of IPT General Mandate.
- 14.4 As there were no questions from the floor, Chairman requested the shareholders to cast their vote for Resolution 8.
- 14.5 Chairman informed the Meeting that China Rubber Technology Group Company Limited and China Hainan Rubber Industry Group Co., Ltd. as well as their associates would abstain from voting on Resolution 8, pursuant to Chapter 9 of the Listing Manual of the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited.
