The Group obtained rights of use for certain plant and equipment under lease arrangements. The average lease term is 2.6 years and all leases are on a fixed repayment basis and some with purchase options.

The carrying amount of rights of use assets as at 30 June 2019 amounted to US\$802,000 and are included in the line item of Property, plant and equipment.

Outstanding capital commitment as at 30 June 2019 is US\$929,000.

The Group entered into a five-year syndication loan facility agreement for NT\$900 million from a consortium of banks in June 2015. As at 30 June 2019, the Group has available credit facility of US\$28,976,000 (31 Dec 2018: US\$29,297,000) with the consortium of banks. The facility is secured against certain property, plant and equipment. As at 30 June 2019, there was no loan outstanding.

Review of Operating Results

Revenue

Revenue for 2Q 2019 increased by 13.2% to US\$5.4 million, compared to US\$4.8 million in 2Q 2018. Revenue for the current half year period increased by 3.8% to US\$11.3 million, compared to US\$10.9 million in the corresponding half year period of 2018, mainly due to the increase in customers' orders.

Cost of sales

Cost of sales for 2Q 2019 decreased by 5.4% to US\$5.3 million, compared to US\$5.6 million in 2Q 2018, mainly due to the prudent control of expenses.

Administration expenses

Administration expenses for 2Q 2019 decreased by 45% to US\$0.4 million, compared to US\$0.7 million in 2Q 2018, mainly due to lower personnel costs and reversed unused accrued expenses.

Income tax benefit

Income tax benefit for 2Q 2019 was US\$0.06 million, compared to income tax expense amounted to US\$0.9 million in 2Q 2018. Income tax benefit for the current half year period was US\$0.2 million, compared to income tax expense amounted to US\$0.7million in the corresponding half year period of 2018, This is mainly due to reversal of undistributed earning tax of 2017.

Financial position of the Group

Cash

Cash decreased by 35% to US\$3.3 million as at 30 June 2019, compared to US\$5 million as at 31 December 2018, mainly due to the payment of US\$2.6 million in capital distribution in 2Q 2019.

Trade receivables

Trade receivables decreased by 13.2% to US\$4.7 million as at 30 June 2019, compared to US\$5.5 million as at 31 December 2018, reflecting the lower sales in 2Q 2019 compared to 4Q 2018.

Property, plant and equipment

Property, plant and equipment decreased by 8.2% to US\$29.8 million as at 30 June 2019, compared to US\$32.4 million as at 31 December 2018, mainly due to depreciation expense charged and recognised impairment loss of US\$0.26 million during the period which were partially offset by additions to property, plant and equipment during the period.



Trade payables

Trade payables decreased by 48% to US\$0.6 million as at 30 June 2019, compared to US\$1.1 million as at 31 December 2018, due to the decrease of purchasing raw materials during the period.

Other payables

Other payables decreased by 15.0% to US\$5.1 million as at 30 June 2019, compared to US\$6.0 million as at 31 December 2018, mainly due to the provision of year-end bonus being paid in February 2019.

Lease liabilities current and non-current

Lease liabilities current and non-current increased by 4.3% to US\$2.9 million as at 30 June 2019, compared to US\$2.8 million as at 31 December 2018, mainly due to more lease arrangements entered for plant and equipment to meet the demands from customers' orders in 1Q2019, and application of SFRS(I) 16 *Leases*.

The global economy continues to be affected by the ongoing trade war between China and the United States, which has negatively affected business confidence. While this year's revenue for the semiconductor industry is expected to decline year-on-year, the long term semiconductor market outlook remains positive.

The Group has kept its primary focus in the testing of automotive applications, and mixed signals, logic and contact image sensors in order to maintain its competitiveness in the industry. The Group has continued investing in and widening its testing capabilities for automotive applications, in line with market specifications requirements.

REPORT ON REVIEW OF INTERIM CONDENSED FINANCIAL INFORMATION FOR GLOBAL TESTING CORPORATION LIMITED AS OF AND FOR THE SECOND QUARTER AND SIX MONTHS ENDED JUNE 30, 2019

Introduction

We have reviewed the accompanying interim condensed financial information of Global Testing Corporation Limited (the "Company") and its subsidiary (the "Group") which comprises the condensed statement of financial position of the Group and the Company as at June 30, 2019, and the condensed statement of profit or loss and other comprehensive income, statement of changes in equity, and cash flow statement of the Group and the condensed statement of changes in equity of the Company for the Second Quarter and Six Months then ended, and selected explanatory notes as enumerated in sections 1, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 11, 12 and 16 of the announcement ("interim condensed financial information").

Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on this interim condensed financial information based on our review.

Scope of Review

We conducted our review in accordance with the Singapore Standard on Review Engagements 2410, *Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity*. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Singapore Standards on Auditing and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

Conclusion

Based on our review, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying interim condensed financial information is not prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with SFRS(I) 1-34.
