FURTHER UPDATE ON GROUP'S AAC BUSINESS OPERATIONS

The Board of Directors (the “**Board**”) of Digilife Technologies Limited (the “**Company**”, together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) refers to the Company's announcement dated 13 May 2026 (“**Previous Announcement**”) in relation to the temporary suspension of the manufacturing operations of its subsidiary, Modi Hebel India LLP (formerly known as Brimax AAC Products LLP).

The Board wishes to provide a further update on the status of the AAC manufacturing operations and the Group's funding initiatives. Since the Previous Announcement, the Board and Management have continued to make efforts to engage with various market participants, financial institutions and potential strategic partners to explore funding options for the recommencement of the AAC manufacturing operations.

The Group has also held discussions with Xella Group, a global building materials company with extensive expertise in autoclaved aerated concrete (AAC) technology and building solutions, and HESS AAC SYSTEMS, a specialist in AAC production technology, machinery and automated production systems, amongst other potential industry and strategic partners, in relation to the proposed revival and recommencement of the AAC manufacturing operations.

Based on the discussions and progress to date, the Board currently expects that it may take a further approximately six (6) to eight (8) months more to secure the necessary funding and complete the arrangements required for the recommencement of the manufacturing operations.

Accordingly, the previously anticipated timeline for resumption of operations around October 2026 will be further extended.

In view of the extended timeline, the Board is taking steps to conserve the Group's financial resources and minimise its operating expenses during the interim period. As the AAC manufacturing facility is currently not operational and represents the Group's only operating business, the Company will remain non-operational during this interim period, with no operating business activities being carried out until the AAC manufacturing operations are recommenced. The Company will, however, continue to maintain the essential corporate, regulatory and compliance functions required during this period.

During this period, the Board will continue its efforts to engage with various potential funding providers and strategic partners with a view to securing the necessary funding and recommencement of the AAC manufacturing operations.

The Board will provide further updates as and when there are material developments.
