UPDATE ON LAWSUIT

Singapore – 2 July 2025

APTT Management Pte. Limited (the “**Trustee-Manager**”), as Trustee-Manager of Asian Pay Television Trust (“**APTT**” or the “**Trust**”) refers to the disclosures made in its 2024 Annual Report (Note 29(ii) on page 143) and earlier financial results announcements regarding the lawsuit filed by a channel provider against Taiwan Broadband Communications Group (“**TBC**”) on account of non-agreement over content costs for the year 2022.

The Trustee-Manager was informed by TBC today that on 30 June 2025, the Intellectual Property and Commercial Court of Taiwan ruled in favour of the channel provider. Under the judgment, TBC has been directed to pay approximately NT\$120 million (approximately S\$5.2 million), inclusive of applicable taxes, to the channel provider. Majority of this amount has already been recognised in the Group’s financial statements for 2022 and 2023 and the balance of approximately NT\$16 million (approximately S\$0.8 million) will be provided for in the Group’s financial statements for 2025. As a result, based on the Trustee-Manager’s preliminary assessment, this judgment will have minimal impact on the Group’s financial results. This development is not expected to cause any disruption to TBC’s services.

The Trustee-Manager will review the detailed written judgment jointly with TBC to determine the appropriate course of action, which may include filing an appeal.
