SGD 200 million fixed rate notes due 2036

Singapore Telecommunications Limited (**Singtel**) today announced that its wholly-owned subsidiary, Singtel Optus Pty Limited (**Optus**), through its wholly-owned subsidiary, Optus Finance Pty Limited (**Optus Finance**), has priced SGD200 million, 10-year fixed rate notes which will be issued on 30 June 2026. The fixed rate notes are guaranteed by Optus and certain of its subsidiaries.

The fixed rate notes will be denominated in Singapore dollars, will carry a coupon of 2.84 per cent per annum and will be drawn down under Optus Finance's EUR3 billion Euro Medium Term Note Programme. The notes will mature on 30 June 2036.

The issue is part of the long-term financing strategy and extends the debt maturity profile of Singtel and its subsidiaries. The net proceeds from the issuance will be swapped into Australian Dollars and applied by Optus towards funding its ordinary course of business.

United Overseas Bank Limited acted as sole lead manager and bookrunner for the issuance.
