The board of directors (the "Board") of Oxley Holdings Limited (the "Company", and together with its subsidiaries, the "Group") is pleased to announce that the Company's wholly-owned subsidiary, Oxley MTN Pte. Ltd. (the "Issuer") has on 30 June 2021 priced its S\$70,000,000 6.9 per cent. notes due 2024 (the "Series 4 Notes") under its U.S.\$1,000,000,000 Guaranteed Euro Medium Term Note Programme (the "Programme"), pursuant to which the Issuer may from time to time issue medium term notes (the "Notes") unconditionally and irrevocably guaranteed (the "Guarantee") by the Company. The Series 4 Notes will bear interest at a fixed rate of 6.9 per cent. per annum and will mature on 8 July 2024.

The Notes are expected to be issued on 8 July 2021, subject to the satisfaction of customary closing conditions. The net proceeds from the issue of the Series 4 Notes are presently intended to be used for general corporate purposes (including the refinancing of borrowings) and working capital and capital expenditure requirements of the Group, its joint venture entities and its associated entities.

Pursuant to Rule 704(31) of the Listing Manual of the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited, the Board wishes to announce that under Condition 9(f) of the Terms and Conditions of the Notes, upon the occurrence of a Change of Control, each holder of the Series 4 Notes will have the option to require the Issuer to redeem such Series 4 Notes together with accrued interest, subject to the Terms and Conditions of the Notes (as amended by the pricing supplement relating to the Notes). A "Change of Control" refers to the occurrence of one or more of the following events:

- (a) the direct or indirect sale, transfer, conveyance or other disposition (other than by way of merger or consolidation), in one or a series of related transactions, of all or substantially all of the properties or assets of the Group, taken as a whole, to any Person other than a Permitted Holder;
- (b) the Permitted Holders are the beneficial owners of less than 51.0% of the total voting power of the Voting Stock of the Company; or
- (c) the adoption of a plan relating to the liquidation or dissolution of the Company.

¹ "Permitted Holders" mean Mr Ching Chiat Kwong, Mr Low See Ching and their respective family members and Affiliates, as more fully described in the Terms and Conditions of the Notes.

If a Change of Control occurs and all outstanding or accrued amounts in connection with Notes become payable, the aggregate level of the outstanding Notes and existing outstanding borrowings of the Group that may be affected as a result of the events described above is approximately \$\$800 million as at 30 June 2021. As at the date of this announcement, there is no Change of Control.

Pursuant to Condition 9(g) of the Terms and Conditions of the Notes:

- (i) if the shares of the Company cease to be traded on the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited (the "SGX-ST"); or
- (ii) if trading in the shares of the Company on the SGX-ST is suspended for a continuous period of more than seven days (other than by reason of holiday, statutory or otherwise),

each holder of the Series 4 Notes will have the option to require the Issuer to redeem such Series 4 Notes together with accrued interest, subject to the Terms and Conditions of the Notes (as amended by the pricing supplement relating to the Notes).

Approval in-principle has been received from the SGX-ST in connection with the Programme and application will be made for the listing and quotation of the Series 4 Notes on the SGX-ST. Approval in-principle from, admission to the Official List of, and listing and quotation of the Programme or the Series 4 Notes on, the SGX-ST are not to be taken as an indication of the merits of the Programme, the Series 4 Notes, the Guarantee, the Issuer, the Company, its subsidiaries, joint ventures and/or associated entities.

Credit Suisse (Singapore) Limited and DBS Bank Ltd. have been appointed by the Company and the Issuer as the arrangers for the Programme. Credit Suisse (Singapore) Limited and DBS Bank Ltd. have been appointed by the Issuer as Joint Bookrunners for the issuance of the Series 4 Notes.

Terms defined in the offering circular dated 28 June 2021 in relation to the Programme (which has been made available on SGXNET) shall have the same meaning in this announcement unless otherwise defined herein.
