As Senior Vice President of HP APJ, Ms Lien led regional operations and strategic initiatives, driving growth and innovation. Later as Managing Director of HP APJ, she oversaw the acquisition of Compaq which led to her being placed on Fortune Magazine’s list of the “50 Most Powerful Women in Business Outside of USA”.

Ms Lien holds a Bachelor of Science in Physics from Nanyang University and a Master's Degree in Computer Science from Imperial College London.
