ENTRY INTO A ROOFTOP SOLAR AGREEMENT BY JOINT OPERATING COMPANY WITH THE AIR SUPPORT DIVISION OF THE BORDER PATROL POLICE IN THAILAND

The board of directors (the “**Board**”) of Interra Resources Limited (the “**Company**” and together with its subsidiaries, the “**Group**”) refers to the announcement issued by the Company dated 8 May 2026 (the “**Incorporation Announcement**”) relating to, among others, the incorporation of Frontier Interra Solar Energy Co., Ltd (the “**JOC**”). The JOC is incorporated by Interra Renewable Energy (Thailand) Co., Ltd. (a wholly-owned subsidiary of the Company) and Frontier Construction Co., Ltd. (“**Frontier Construction**”). Please refer to the Incorporation Announcement for further information about the incorporation of the JOC.

The Company wishes to announce that the JOC, in the capacity of a service provider, has entered into an agreement with the Air Support Division of the Border Patrol Police in Thailand (the “**Counterparty**”) dated 7 May 2026 for, among others, the installation of a rooftop solar power system (the “**Rooftop Solar Agreement**”).

Pursuant to the Rooftop Solar Agreement, the JOC will install a rooftop solar power system at the Counterparty’s premises and sell electricity produced by the JOC’s system to the Counterparty. The Counterparty agrees to purchase all electricity produced by the system installed pursuant to the Rooftop Solar Agreement from the JOC, subject to the terms and conditions of the Rooftop Solar Agreement.

The JOC’s entry into the Rooftop Solar Agreement is not expected to have any material impact on the net tangible assets per share and earnings per share of the Company for the financial year ending 31 December 2026.

As at the date of this announcement, none of the Company’s directors or substantial shareholders has any interest, direct or indirect, in the Rooftop Solar Agreement other than through their respective interests (if any) in the share capital of the Company.

No person is proposed to be appointed to the Board as part of the Rooftop Solar Agreement and no director’s service contract is proposed to be entered into by the Company with any person in connection with the Rooftop Solar Agreement.
