



Examples of NVH and non-NVH Products



NVH COMPONENTS AND NON-NVH COMPONENTS

■ Engine compartment insulation

A range of engine compartment insulation components such as hood insulators and dash outer insulators. These components are incorporated into the hoods and engine casings of automobiles to reduce sound emission, vibrations, and heat generated from the engine into the environment and interior cabin of the automobile.

Under-body shielding systems

Under-body shielding systems are incorporated into the undercarriage of automobiles to provide insulation from external noise and vibrations to the interior cabin. Under-body shielding systems also influence the aerodynamic performance of an automobile.

■ Interior system insulation

Interior system insulation components such as inner dash systems are incorporated into the dashboard of automobiles to insulate the cabin from NVH emitted from the engine compartment.

Headliner

Headliners for Mazda are assembled at the assembly plant in Kulim Hi-tech Park.

Trunk systems

MeGroup manufactures trunk systems such as trunk floor and trunk side liners in a variety of coverings. The trunk systems are used to line the boots of an automobile.











Dealership Outlet Locality






FY2022 Highlights




FY2022 Highlights – Revenue ('RM million)




FY2022 Highlights

Gross Profit ('RM million)


FY'22 Gross Profit by Segment ('RM million)

FY2022 ESG Initiatives

Environmental

- Installed solar panels in our main manufacturing facility to reduce carbon footprint and overhead expenses by tapping on solar energy
- Installation works of the solar panels on the roof of the Main Manufacturing Plant was completed in December 2021 and utilisation of renewable solar energy has started since January 2022
- The Group has achieved its FY2022 goal of more than 10% reduction in the monthly average electricity consumption from non-renewable energy from Balakong MP, resulting in total electricity savings of c.RM18,000 since January 2022 to end FY2022

Social

- Achieved zero cases of Workplace Safety and Health Complaint
- Achieved zero cases of industrial accidents
- Adopt 'equal opportunity employer' work practices

Governance

- Achieved zero incident of regulatory noncompliance by all employees, officers and directors

Outlook

- The Malaysia government has entered the "Transition to Endemic" phase from 1 April 2022, with all restrictions on business operating hours removed and the easing of its Covid-19 safety measures starting from 1 May 2022
- The Malaysian Automotive Association (MAA) announced on 20 January 2022 that the Total Industry Volume ("TIV") in the 12 months to December 2021 calendar year in Malaysia was 508,911 units, a 4% decline compared to the 12 months to December 2020 calendar year
- MAA also forecasted that the total TIV for the 12 months to December 2022 will be 600,000 units, comprising 540,000 units of passenger vehicles and 60,000 units of commercial vehicles. For the first 6 months 2022, MAA reported that TIV registered was 331,386 units, 33% higher than the same period a year ago, driven largely by commercial vehicles which registered a 49.2% year-on-year growth
- MAA also reported that the total production volume for first half of 2022 increased 31.8% year-on-year to reach 317,933 units, led by a recovery in both passenger vehicles and commercial vehicles
- According to MAA, following the government's decision of not extending sales tax exemption incentive for
 passenger vehicles (under the PEMERKASA+ package) after 30 June 2022, there has been a strong up-tick
 in demand for new vehicles. That said, the automotive sector continues to remain challenging due to a
 supply chain disruption in chips, affecting the sales of certain automobile models
