INCOME STATEMENT

Group turnover decreased by \$\$11.2 million or 26.5% from \$\$42.1 million for the three months ended 31 December 2013 (1Q2014) to \$\$30.9 million for the three months ended 31 December 2014 (1Q2015). The decrease in revenue was mainly due to completion of more construction projects in 1Q2014.

Gross profit increased from \$\$5.8 million in 1Q2014 to \$\$6.5 million in 1Q2015. Gross profit margin improved from 13.7% in 1Q2014 to 20.9% in 1Q2015, mainly due to a change in product mix with higher margin.

Distribution costs decreased from S\$0.7 million in 1Q2014 to S\$0.6 million in 1Q2015, which is in line with the decrease in sales volume. Administrative costs increased from S\$2.6 million in 1Q2014 to S\$2.8 million in 1Q2015 mainly due to an increase in accrued personnel expenses. Other operating costs decreased from S\$0.7 million in 1Q2014 to S\$0.2 million in 1Q2015, mainly due to higher foreign exchange gain in 1Q2015.

The Group's effective tax rate was 15.3% for 1Q2015 as compared to 9.4% for 1Q2014. The lower effective tax rate for 1Q2014 was mainly due to utilisation of more tax incentive for a Malaysian subsidiary.

In view of the above circumstances, the Group posted profit after tax of S\$2.5 million in 1Q2015, compared to S\$1.9 million in 1Q2014.

BALANCE SHEET

As at 31 December 2014, property, plant and equipment amounted to S\$37.7 million as compared to S\$29.4 million as at 30 September 2014. The increase was mainly due to the acquisition of a new factory building by a Malaysian subsidiary.

Inventories increased from S\$32.5 million as at 30 September 2014 to S\$35.7 million as at 31 December 2014, mainly due to timing difference on progressive delivery for projects.

Trade debtors decreased from \$\$33.2 million as at 30 September 2014 to \$\$32.6 million as at 31 December 2014. The reduction was mainly due to collection of trade debts, following completion of some construction projects.

Cash and cash equivalents decreased from \$\$35.5 million as at 30 September 2014 to \$\$27.3 million as at 31 December 2014, mainly due to acquisition of a new factory building by a Malaysian subsidiary.

The slow down in local property market, coupled with an increasing number of competitors, are expected to exert pressure on profit margins.

Barring unforeseen circumstances, the Group expects to remain profitable for the next 12 months.
