Alliance Healthcare Wins Contract to Provide Managed Healthcare Solutions to Major Healthcare Institutions

Announcement Highlights:

- One of two successful applicants to provide managed healthcare solutions to major healthcare institutions for a period of two years
- Alliance Healthcare to deliver outpatient medical and/or dental clinic services to an estimate of more than 80,000¹ individuals comprising employees of healthcare institutions and their dependants

Singapore, 2 January 2020 – Alliance Healthcare Group Limited (SGX: MIJ), an integrated healthcare organisation that leverages on technology to provide a broad suite of healthcare services primarily in Singapore ("Alliance Healthcare" and together with its subsidiaries, the "Group"), is pleased to announce that the Group is one of two successful applicants which has been awarded a contract by way of public tender to provide managed healthcare solutions to 38 companies (the "Entities"). The Group has signed a master services agreement with ALPS Pte. Ltd. (the "Agent"), which is acting for and on behalf of each of the Entities, to provide managed healthcare solutions for the employees of the Entities and their dependants. The Entities include major healthcare institutions, such as Changi General Hospital, KK Women's and Children's Hospital, Singapore General Hospital and National Health Group Polyclinics.

Alliance Healthcare expects to deliver outpatient medical and/or dental clinic services to an estimate of more than 80,000 individuals for a period of 2 years, from 1 January 2020 to 31 December 2021. The agreement may be extended at the option of the Agent for another 1 year, subject to satisfactory performance review of the services provided by the Group.

Executive Chairman and CEO of Alliance Healthcare, Dr Barry Thng Lip Mong (唐立茂) commented, "We are honoured that Alliance Healthcare is one of only two successful applicants to be awarded the contract to provide managed healthcare solutions to the
