Civmec wins major wastewater treatment plant contract

SINGAPORE – 7 November 2016 – Australia-based **Civmec Limited** (“Civmec” or the “Group”) in joint venture with Black & Veatch (BCJV), has been awarded an EPC alliance model contract with the Water Corporation of Western Australia for the design and construction of the Woodman Point Wastewater Treatment Plant Upgrade to 180ml/day. The plant is located 22km south-east of Perth, Western Australia.

The upgrade to the Woodman Point Wastewater Treatment Plant comprises:

- New grit removal facility;
- New flow distribution channel;
- Expansion of existing odour collection and treatment systems;
- New sedimentation tanks; and
- Conversion of the existing batch reactor to a permanent aeration facility.

The contract awarded to BCJV will commence in December 2016 with approximately 200 personnel employed on the project at its peak and with construction on site scheduled to be completed by the end of 2019.

Mr. Patrick Tallon, Chief Executive Officer said, “Following a rigorous proposal process we are extremely pleased that the Water Corporation have selected the Civmec and Black & Veatch joint venture as the successful proponent for these critical works. We see water and wastewater infrastructure as a long-term business opportunity and are committed to working together with our partner to deliver the best project outcome for the Water Corporation and the local community. This is an excellent award for our hardworking workforce and is especially significant given the close proximity of the work site to our Henderson facilities.”

The BCJV is a 50:50 unincorporated joint venture between Civmec Construction and Engineering Pty Ltd and Black & Veatch Australia Pty Ltd.
