The Valuation Date for the HSI Call Warrants is 30 January 2020 or if such day is not the day on which the Hang Seng Index January 2020 Futures Contract expires on the Hong Kong Futures Exchange Limited, the day on which the Hang Seng Index January 2020 Futures Contract will expire on the Hong Kong Futures Exchange Limited or its successor or assign.

Closing Level: The final settlement price for settling the Hang Seng Index January 2020 Futures Contract determined pursuant to Regulation 012 of the Regulations for trading Stock Index Futures and the Contract Specifications for Hang Seng Index Futures Contracts (as amended from time to time) of the Hong Kong Futures Exchange Limited

The Valuation Date for the HSI Put Warrants is 30 January 2020 or if such day is not the day on which the Hang Seng Index January 2020 Futures Contract expires on the Hong Kong Futures Exchange Limited, the day on which the Hang Seng Index January 2020 Futures Contract will expire on the Hong Kong Futures Exchange Limited or its successor or assign.

Warrantheolders will not be required to deliver an exercise notice. If the Cash Settlement Amount (less any Exercise Expenses) is positive, all Warrants will be deemed to have been automatically exercised at 12:00 noon (Singapore time) on the Expiry Date (or if the Valuation Date falls after the Expiry Date, the Expiry Date shall be the Business Day following the Valuation Date). The Cash Settlement Amount less the Exercise Expenses in respect of the Warrants will be paid in the manner set out in the terms and conditions of the Warrants. In the event the Cash Settlement Amount (less any Exercise Expenses) is zero or negative, all Warrants will be deemed to have expired at 12:00 noon (Singapore time) on the Expiry Date (or if the Valuation Date falls after the Expiry Date, the Expiry Date shall be the Business Day following the Valuation Date) and Warrantheolders will not be entitled to receive any payment from the Issuer in respect of the Warrants.
