Trek partners Aboard Al Inc. to develop Al-driven aviation safety and fleet management solution

- New system leverages real-time flight data to enhance aircraft safety, reduce downtime, and improve operational efficiency.

Aboard AI is a leading technology company dedicated to revolutionising aviation safety through real-time intelligence. Through its proprietary platform, Aboard AI leverages data-driven insights, predictive maintenance, and scalable machine learning models to deliver solutions that empower pilots with actionable insights for smarter and safer flight operations.

Under the agreement, the partnership combines Trek's patented wireless memory technologies, which leverage NAND and Dram systems for data intensive processing and secure transmission, with Aboard Al's proprietary artificial intelligence algorithms to compute and analyse real-time flight data.

The collaboration is projected to generate in excess of US\$15 million (S\$20 million) in revenue, which is expected to contribute to the Group's performance through FY2027. The partnership will primarily focus on the North American market, capitalising on the region's growing aviation software market.

By harnessing advanced AI analytics powered by Trek's wireless memory technologies, the solution bridges the gap of underutilised data and effectively analyses the vast volumes of inflight data, enabling the aviation operators to detect early warning indicators and reduce the risk of operational downtime. To further strengthen operational efficiency, the system can be integrated with multiple platforms, including maintenance and debriefing tools, to facilitate data analysis and unlock untapped value within the aviation ecosystem.

The global aviation software market is projected to reach US\$18.6 billion by 2030, registering a CAGR of 6.9%, with North America representing the largest regional market¹. The industry growth is underpinned by a surge in pilot training, increased business travel, and rising private aircraft ownership creating strong demand for data-driven flight-safety innovations.
