

Thomson Medical Group Launches Johor Bay Mega Project of Over MYR18 Billion GDV, Shaping Johor's Future Skyline

- 26-acre masterplan anchored by a healthcare nucleus of a multi-disciplinary hospital, specialist suites, aged care and assisted living, and healthcare peripherals; complemented by luxury residences, hospitality, and vibrant commercial-lifestyle precincts
- Minutes from RTS, CIQ and ferry terminal, Johor Bay is a one-of-a-kind development combining a prestigious address, premium quality, and elevated sea views – the 'Marina Bay' of Johor

JOHOR BAHRU / SINGAPORE, 25th August 2025 – Leading Southeast Asian healthcare player, Thomson Medical Group today unveiled the highly-anticipated landmark Johor Bay mega development: an integrated project bringing together world-class healthcare, luxury residential and hospitality, commercial, and lifestyle elements spanning an impressive 26 acres and carrying a projected gross development value (GDV) of over MYR18 billion. Set in the heart of the Johor-Singapore Special Economic Zone (JS-SEZ), the masterplan is one of the most expansive private healthcare and real estate ventures on prime land in Southeast Asia to-date.

The mega waterfront project is an integrated ecosystem purpose-built for cross-border healthcare, luxury urban living, hospitality, lifestyle and long-term investment with Thomson Hospital Iskandariah as one of the anchor developments. The project capitalises on the momentum of Johor's attractive balance of high standards of living and manageable living costs; the imminent completion of the RTS; and the increasing momentum behind the JS-SEZ.

"This is the result of the Group's conviction in Johor's long-term potential as a jewel in the region," said Kiat Lim, Executive Vice-Chairman of Thomson Medical Group. "The time is right: economic tailwinds, infrastructure momentum, and demographic shifts are converging. We have built a vision for a mega project that will shape the skyline and the future of the JS-SEZ bay area for years to come."



The 'Marina Bay' of Johor: Combining a strategic location, luxury quality and elevated sea views for exclusive privacy

Located just 1.2km from the upcoming RTS station at Bukit Chagar and minutes from the Causeway and regional ferry terminals, Johor Bay offers unparalleled connectivity without compromising on privacy and exclusivity. Elevated above the urban bustle, the development combines a prestigious address, sweeping sea views, and premium design and quality, creating a rare waterfront enclave that looks out on Singapore, and stands apart from the density of conventional urban projects – the 'Marina Bay' of Johor.

A Multi-Faceted Ecosystem: Healthcare, Urban Living and a Lifestyle Destination

Johor Bay's sprawling 26-acre freehold development is strategically zoned to include:

- Residential and hospitality zone: Over 9 acres are earmarked for high-end residences
 that blend urban convenience with waterfront serenity. A separate 2-acre plot is
 expected to house a five-star hotel, premium serviced residences, commercial, and
 lifestyle offerings, catering to regional tourism and medical travellers.
- Healthcare nucleus: The 9-acre cluster, anchored by the multi-disciplinary Thomson Hospital Iskandariah, will also include specialist medical suites, aged care and assisted living, specialised post-natal care facilities, step-down care, and a Grade A life sciences office tower.

With Thomson Hospital Iskandariah sitting at the heart of the extensive healthcare cluster, there will be ample space to enable the hospital to expand from the planned 500-bed capacity to easily over 1,000 beds.

This healthcare nucleus – forming one of Southeast Asia's most comprehensive private healthcare environments – directly addresses long-term demand drivers: the region's ageing population, the rise of chronic illnesses, and increasing appetite for private healthcare and medical tourism.

• Lifestyle and public realm: Inspired by world-class urban districts, Johor Bay includes The Boulevard — a vibrant pedestrian avenue; The Canyon — a lush green corridor connecting key amenities; and a marina promenade designed to activate the waterfront year-round. All these elements combine to further reinforce the luxurious surroundings of the project.



The integrated masterplan is designed to meet the ongoing shifts in demand and demographic trends in Johor, as the JS-SEZ attracts a new wave of cross-border professionals, medical travellers and workers, investors, and regional homeowners.

Phase One Launch: MYR3.1 Billion GDV and Over 1,200 Jobs to Accelerate JS-SEZ's Wider Growth Agenda

With a total estimated GDV exceeding MYR3.1 billion, Phase One of the Johor Bay project will kick off with the multi-disciplinary private Thomson Hospital Iskandariah and a 47-storey ultra-luxury residential tower, marking the first step in a long-term, multi-phase development aimed at establishing Johor Bahru as a premier hub for healthcare, lifestyle, and commerce in Southeast Asia.

Billed as "villas in the sky", the residential tower – with its premium address, elevated sea views, and luxury design and quality – will feature approximately 180 exclusive units that offer expansive sky gardens, cloud forest elements, and integrated wellness amenities.

Early expressions of interest have indicated a strong appetite for the property from regional investors, overseas homeowners and cross-border professionals, signalling confidence in the project's combination of luxury waterfront living and proximity to Singapore.

Phase One alone is projected to generate more than 1,200 direct and indirect jobs during its construction and operational phases. This supports the JS-SEZ's wider ambition of creating 20,000 skilled jobs over five years and is a cornerstone in the evolving Johor-Singapore economic corridor.

Recent months have seen increased bilateral focus on unlocking the full potential of the JS-SEZ, with both governments signalling strong intent to deepen co-operation. Central to this vision is the enhancement of Johor's healthcare infrastructure and economic development. The Johor state government has also convened a special task force to address healthcare accessibility and capacity, underscoring the need for high-quality private healthcare infrastructure to complement public services and support the growing demands of the cross-border population.

"The Johor Bay project is a timely and strategic development that supports the state's long-term goals. Not only will the Thomson Hospital Iskandariah project help strengthen Johor's position as a premier healthcare hub in Southeast Asia, but the wider Johor Bay project will add to our overall economic growth agenda under the JS-SEZ. We welcome investments like Johor Bay that create jobs, enhance healthcare access, attract good collaborators and reinforce Johor's standing as a vital partner in regional progress," said YAB Dato' Onn Hafiz bin Ghazi, Menteri Besar of Johor.

Thomson Medical remains firmly focused on its role as a leading healthcare provider and will explore opportunities to unlock value from non-core real estate assets, while continuing to expand its healthcare footprint and strengthen its long-term position in the region.
