UPDATE ON LEGAL PROCEEDINGS

The Board of Directors (the “**Board**”) of Renaissance United Limited (the “**Company**”) wishes to update shareholders on the Sawyer Falls Co., L.L.C. Legal Suit which was first announced on 15 December 2020, in which its indirect wholly owned subsidiary Capri Investments L.L.C. (“**Capri**”) is the defendant.

Defined terms used in this announcement have the same meaning as used in its latest announcement on the matter on 31 August 2022.

As announced, on 29 August 2022, Judge Schwartz of the Superior Court in Pierce County ordered that all remaining proceeds from the purchase and sale agreement with KB Home be placed in an interest-bearing special purpose account, to be held until the conclusion of the litigation. In granting the said relief, Sawyer Falls was ordered to provide a bond in the amount of US\$75,000.00 as security for costs and damages that may be incurred by Capri.

The Board wishes to announce that on 21 December 2022 US Pacific Time, the Washington State Court of Appeals, Division II Court Commissioner ordered (i) that Capri’s motion for discretionary review is granted, and (ii) that the Superior Court’s Preliminary Injunction is stayed pending further decision of the Washington State Court of Appeals.

The ruling, which found that the Superior Court committed probable error in issuing the Preliminary Injunction, authorises Capri to present its challenge immediately and directly to the Court of Appeals.

The Board will update shareholders as and when there are further material developments in this litigation.

In the meantime, the Board wishes to advise shareholders and investors to exercise caution when dealing in the shares of the Company. Persons who are in doubt as to the action they should take should consult their stockbrokers, bank managers, solicitors, accountants or other professional advisers.
