E. Notes to the Condensed Interim Consolidated Financial Statements

1. Corporate information

Versalink Holdings Limited (the "Company") is incorporated in Singapore with limited liability. The Company is listed on the Catalist board of the Singapore Exchange Securities Trading Limited on 24 September 2014.

The board of directors approved and authorised these condensed interim consolidated financial statements for issue on the date of this announcement. The directors have the power to amend and reissue the financial statements.

These condensed interim consolidated financial statements as at and for the six months ended 31 August 2025 comprise the Company and its subsidiaries (the "Group").

The principal activities of the Company are those of an investment holding company and the provision of management services.

The principal activities of the subsidiaries are manufacturing, marketing and sale of system furniture and other furniture related products.

The financial information contained in this announcement has neither been audited nor reviewed by the Company's auditors.

The latest audited annual consolidated financial statements of the Group for the year ended 28 February 2025 are not subject to an adverse opinion, qualified opinion or disclaimer of opinion issued by the Company's auditors.

The condensed interim consolidated financial statements are presented in Ringgit Malaysia ("RM") and all financial information have been rounded to the nearest thousand (RM'000), except when otherwise stated.

2. Basis of preparation

The condensed interim consolidated financial statements for the six months ended 31 August 2025 have been prepared in accordance with Singapore Financial Reporting Standards (International) ("SFRS(I)s") 1-34 Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Singapore Accounting Standards Council.

The condensed interim consolidated financial statements do not include all the information required for a complete set of financial statements. However, selected explanatory notes are included to explain events and transactions that are significant to an understanding of the changes in the Group's financial position and performance of the Group since the last audited annual consolidated financial statements for the year ended 28 February 2025.

2. Basis of preparation (Continued)

The accounting policies and methods of computation adopted are consistent with those adopted by the Company in its most recently audited annual consolidated financial statements for the year ended 28 February 2025, which were prepared in accordance with SFRS(I)s, except for the adoption of new and amended standards as set out in Note 2.1 below.

Accounting convention

The condensed interim consolidated financial statements are prepared on a going concern basis under the historical cost convention except where a financial reporting standard requires an alternative treatment (such as fair values) as disclosed where appropriate in these financial statements. The accounting policies in the financial reporting standards may not be applied when the effect of applying them is not material. The disclosures required by financial reporting standards may not be provided if the information resulting from that disclosure is not material.

2.1 New and amended standards adopted by the Group

Other than the adoption of the new and amended standards from prior reporting year, there were no changes in accounting policies and methods of computation adopted in the condensed interim consolidated financial statements as compared to the most recently audited annual consolidated financial statements for the year ended 28 February 2025, which were in accordance with SFRS(I)s. These applicable new and amended standards did not require any significant modification of the measurement methods or the presentation in the financial statements.

2.2 Critical judgements, assumptions and estimation uncertainties

These estimates and assumptions are periodically monitored to ensure they incorporate all relevant information available at the date when financial statements are prepared. However, this does not prevent actual figures differing from estimates. The nature and the carrying amount of such significant assets and liabilities are disclosed with further details in the relevant Notes to these condensed interim consolidated financial statements.

The significant judgements made by management in applying the Group's accounting policies and the key sources of estimation uncertainty were the same as those that were applied to the audited annual consolidated financial statements as at and for the year ended 28 February 2025.

Estimates and underlying assumptions are reviewed on an ongoing basis. Revisions to accounting estimates are recognised in the period in which the estimates are revised and in any future periods affected.

3 Seasonal operations

The Group's business are not affected significantly by seasonal or cyclical factors during the financial period.

4. Segment and revenue information

The Group is organised into the following major business segments:

- (i) Domestic sales segment ("Domestic") sales of office furniture derived from local market; and
- (ii) Export sales segment ("Export") sales of office furniture to countries overseas.

These operating segments are reported in manner consistent with internal reporting provided to the operating decision maker who are responsible for allocating resources and assessing performance of the operating segments.

1. Review

The condensed interim consolidated statement of financial position of the Company and its subsidiaries as at 31 August 2025 and the related condensed interim consolidated profit or loss and other comprehensive income, condensed interim consolidated statement of changes in equity and condensed interim consolidated statement of cash flow for the six months ended 31 August 2025 and explanatory notes have not been audited or reviewed by the Company's auditors.

2. Review of the performance of the Group

2.1 Review of Statement of Profit or Loss and Other Comprehensive Income

Turnover

The Group's revenue decreased by approximately RM1.07 million or approximately 5.2% from approximately RM20.61 million for six months ended 31 August 2024 ("1H FY2025") to approximately RM19.53 million for six months ended 31 August 2025 ("1H FY2026").

The decrease was mainly due to lower revenue contribution from the export segment, partially offset by the higher revenue contribution from the domestic segment. Domestic segment recorded a higher revenue of approximately RM11.13 million in 1H FY2026 as compared to approximately RM10.40 million in 1H FY2025 whilst export segment recorded a lower revenue of approximately RM8.40 million in 1H FY2026, as compared to approximately RM10.21 million in 1H FY2025. The increase in revenue for domestic segment was mainly due to the increased demand in office furniture spending in Malaysia whilst decrease in revenue for export was mainly due to reduction in sales demand from North America of approximately RM2.30 million in 1H FY2026 (1H FY2025: RM4.19 million) in light of global uncertainty which may be exacerbated by the tariffs situation.

Cost of sales

Cost of sales decreased by approximately RM0.09 million, or approximately 0.6% from approximately RM14.84 million in 1H FY2025 to approximately RM14.75 million in 1H FY2026. The decrease in cost of sales was mainly due to the overall reduction in the Group's revenue of RM1.07 million.

Gross profit

The gross profit margin decreased from approximately 28.0% in 1H FY2025 to approximately 24.5% in 1H FY2026. The decrease in gross profit margin was mainly due to the written off of finished goods of approximately RM0.56 million in 1H FY2026.

Interest income

Interest income increased from approximately RM0.13 million in 1H FY2025 to approximately RM0.17 million in 1H FY2026 mainly due to increase in interest income of approximately RM0.04 million from banks.

Other income and gains

Other income and gains decreased from approximately RM0.81 million in 1H FY2025 to approximately RM0.29 million in 1H FY2026 mainly due to absence of (i) write back of slow-moving stock of RM0.26 million; (ii) write back of provision of royalty expenses of RM0.12 million; and (iii) sales of scrap and Human Resources Development Fund claim of an aggregate of RM0.14 million in IH FY2025.

Marketing and distribution expenses

Marketing and distribution expenses decreased by approximately RM0.34 million or approximately 20.8% from approximately RM1.63 million in 1H FY2025 to approximately RM1.29 million in 1H FY2026. This was mainly due to the decrease in (i) advertisement & promotion of approximately RM0.02 million; (ii) sales commission of approximately RM0.08 million; (iii) employee benefit expenses of approximately RM0.05 million; (iv) logistics cost of approximately RM0.05 million; (v) drawing and design fee of approximately RM0.08 million; and (vi) travelling expenses of approximately RM0.06 million.

Administrative expenses

Administrative expenses increased by approximately RM2.76 million or approximately 59.4% from approximately RM4.65 million in 1H FY2025 to approximately RM7.41 million in 1H FY2026. This was mainly due to the partial refund of the purchase consideration of RM1.2 million by the Group as certain conditions were not met in respect to the sale and leaseback agreement dated 23 September 2022 with RHB Trustees Berhad for Axis Real Estate Investment Trust for the sale of freehold land and building at RM41,000,000 and the increase in general adminstrative expenses.

Depreciation expenses

Depreciation expenses for plant and equipment decreased from approximately RM0.67 million in 1H FY2025 to approximately RM0.51 million in 1H FY2026 mainly due to the decrease of RM0.16 million from depreciation of mould, office equipment, plant and machinery in 1H FY2026.

Depreciation expenses for right-of-use assets remain unchanged, at approximately RM0.53 million for 1H FY2026 (1H FY2025: RM0.53 million).

Other losses

Other losses decreased from approximately RM0.97 million in 1H FY2025 to approximately RM0.55 million in 1H FY2026. It was mainly attributed to the decrease of foreign exchange loss of approximately RM0.42 million due to the strengthening of Malaysia Ringgit against foreign currencies such as the United States Dollar and Singapore Dollar.

Finance costs

Finance costs decreased from approximately RM0.13 million in 1H FY2025 to approximately RM0.12 million in 1H FY2026 mainly due to decrease in interest of lease liabilities arising from right-of-use asset of approximately RM0.06 million and banker acceptance interest of approximately RM0.02 million.

Loss net of tax

As a result of the above, the Group reported a net loss after tax of approximately RM4.14 million in 1H FY2026 as compared to a net loss after tax of approximately RM0.68 million in 1H FY2025.

2.2 Review of Statement of Financial Position

Non-Current Assets

As at 31 August 2025, the Group's non-current assets amounted to approximately RM2.92 million or approximately 10.3% of the Group's total assets and comprised the following:

- (i) plant and equipment of approximately RM2.65 million or approximately 90.9% of the Group's total noncurrent assets. The decrease in plant and equipment of approximately RM0.35 million was mainly due to depreciation of plant and machinery of approximately RM0.51 million, partially offset by the acquisition of plant and machinery of approximately RM0.17 million.
- (ii) right-of-use assets of approximately RM0.27 million or approximately 9.1% of the Group's total non-current assets. The decrease in right-of-use assets of approximately RM0.53 million was mainly due to the depreciation of right-of-use assets.

Current Assets

As at 31 August 2025, the Group's current assets amounted to approximately RM25.52 million or approximately 89.7% of the Group's total assets and comprised the following:

- (i) inventories of approximately RM4.32 million or approximately 16.9% of the Group's total current assets, which comprised raw materials, work-in-progress and finished goods. The decrease in inventories of approximately RM1.40 million was mainly due to written off of obsolete, discontinue product and defect inventories.
- (ii) trade and other receivables of approximately RM2.23 million or approximately 8.7% of the Group's total current assets. The decrease in trade and other receivables of approximately RM1.96 million was mainly due to witten off of deposit paid of RM1.0 million and reduction of trade receivables outstanding of RM0.96 million.
- (iii) other non-financial assets of approximately RM1.71 million or approximately 6.7% of the Group's total current assets. The decrease in other non-financial assets of approximately RM0.28 million was mainly due to the reduction of other receivables of approximately RM0.28 million.
- (iv) cash and cash equivalents of approximately RM17.26 million or approximately 67.6% of the Group's total current assets. Please refer to the section entitled "Review of Statement of Cash Flows" below for the movements in the Group's cash and cash equivalents.

Non-Current Liabilities

As at 31 August 2025, the Group's non-current liabilities amounted to approximately RM0.11 million or approximately 0.8% of the Group's total liabilities and comprised the following:

- deferred tax liabilities of approximately RM0.08 million or approximately 73.2% of the Group's total noncurrent liabilities.
- (ii) other financial liabilities of approximately RM0.03 million or approximately 26.8% of the Group's total noncurrent liabilities.

Current Liabilities

As at 31 August 2025, the Group's current liabilities amounted to approximately RM14.25 million or approximately 99.2% of the Group's total liabilities and comprised the following:

- (i) trade and other payables of approximately RM7.77 million or approximately 54.52% of the Group's total current liabilities which mainly consist of (a) trade payables of approximately RM1.41 million, and (b) other payables of approximately RM6.36 million. The increase in trade and other payables of approximately RM1.42 million was mainly due to increase in other payables of approximately RM2.88 million; and partly offset by decrease in trade payables of approximately RM1.47 million.
- (ii) other financial liabilities of approximately RM4.12 million or approximately 28.89% of the Group's total current liabilities which mainly consist of (a) banker's acceptance of approximately RM0.56 million, (b) amount due to director of approximately RM2.52 million, and (c) amount due to shareholders of approximately RM1.03 million. The increase in other financial liabilities of approximately RM1.34 million was due to increase usage of banker's acceptance; and the loans extended by Mr Ge Shuming (Executive Director and Chief Executive Officer of the Company) to the Company. Please refer to Note 6 below for more information in relation to the loans.
- (iii) lease liabilities of approximately RM0.68 million or approximately 4.80% of the Group's total current liabilities. The decrease in lease liabilities of approximately RM1.30 million was due to repayment of lease instalment of approximately RM1.30 million.
- (iv) provisions of approximately RM1.68 million or approximately 11.79% of the Group's current liabilities.

Shareholders' equity

As at 31 August 2025, the Group's equity attributable to equity holders was approximately RM14.08 million, comprising share capital of approximately RM36.44 million, and net capital deficit of approximately RM22.34 million.

Working Capital Position

The Group reported a positive working capital position of approximately RM11.27 million as at 31 August 2025, as compared to approximately RM14.54 million as at 28 February 2025.

2.3 Review of Statement of Cash Flows

As at 31 August 2025, the Group recorded cash and cash equivalents of approximately RM17.26 million as compared to approximately RM15.43 million as at 1 March 2025.

Net cash generated from operating activities for 1H FY2026 amounted to approximately RM1.45 million. This was mainly due to operating cash outflows before changes in working capital of approximately RM3.16 million and net working capital inflows of approximately RM4.77 million. The net inflow was mainly due to (i) the decrease in inventories of approximately RM1.40 million; (ii) the decrease in other non-financial assets of approximately RM0.44 million; (iii) the decrease in trade and other receivables of approximately RM1.96 million; and (iv) the increase in trade and other payables of approximately RM0.97 million. In addition, income tax of approximately RM0.16 million was paid in 1H FY2026.

Net cash generated from investing activities for 1H FY2026 amounted to approximately RM0.09 million. This was mainly due to the placement of fixed deposits of approximately RM0.09 million, and purchase of plant and equipment of approximately RM0.16 million, which were partially offset by interest received of approximately RM0.17 million.

Net cash generated from financing activities for 1H FY2026 amounted to approximately RM0.02 million. This was mainly due to (i) banker's acceptance drawdown (net of repayment) of approximately RM0.15 million; (ii) amount due to directors of approximately RM1.16 million; (iii) amount due to shareholders of approximately RM0.03 million; and (iv) placement of fixed deposits of approximately RM0.09 million, partially offset by (i) repayment of lease liabilities of approximately RM1.31 million; and (ii) interest paid of approximately RM0.11 million.

The global economy outlook is expected to remain uncertain and volatile as a result of prolonged geopolitical conflict in the Middle East as well as between Russia and Ukraine, the changing rates of tariff imposed by USA and foreign exchange rates fluctuation.

Red Sea disruption causes ocean freight spiked resulting escalation of logistic cost and the strengthening of Ringgit Malaysia against US Dollar will continue to affect the financial performance of the Group.

In view of above, the Group will continue to remain resilient and vigilant in addressing the uncertainties and also align its strategies of cost controlling, enhancing production efficiency, exploring new markets and products with the prevailing market situation.

The Company is in the process of exploring new business opportunities to diversify its revenue stream and strengthen shareholders' value. At the same time, the Company is also looking to capital markets to explore fundraising opportunities to strengthen its cash and financial position, and in this regard, the Company has been in discussions with potential investors who have shown keen interest in investing into the Company.

5. Dividend

The Board of Directors of the Company has decided not to declare or recommend any dividends for 1H FY2026 (1H FY2025: Nil) as the Group conserves funds for working capital.

6. Interested person transactions

The Group does not have a general mandate from shareholders for interested person transactions pursuant to Rule 920 of the Catalist Rules.

There were no interested person transactions exceeding \$\$100,000 entered into by the Group during the current financial period. The Company had entered into four (4) loan agreements with Mr Ge Shuming ("Mr Ge"), a director of the Company on 26 May 2025, 29 June 2025, 7 August 2025, and 21 August 2025 respectively in which Mr Ge granted total loan of \$\$340,000 to the Company for its working capital purposes for a period of 1 year at interest rate of 5% per annum, which total interest for the four (4) loans to be paid by the Company amounted to \$\$17,000 (equivalent to RM56,234), representing approximately 0.31% of the Group's net tangible assets for the latest audited financial statements for financial year ended 28 February 2025.
